Data Protection

Images from the CCTV cameras are stored on systems owned by MVHT. Supervised access to stored images is available on request for those who can show a reason to need it. This may include police and the parish council, as well as hall users. Copies of images may be made available to police or the parish council for the investigation of crime occurring on or off the property.

Images are stored when motion is detected within the boundaries of the Hall property and the adjacent parish council property. The public highway and footway are normally out of the field of view.

Images are recorded of the outside parts of the property and in the lobby. No images are recorded in the main hall, Queen Elizabeth II Room, toilets, or storerooms, except by line of sight through open doors. Recording in the garden (daytime only) and lobby can be turned off for groups with vulnerable clients where the existence of recordings could give rise to Safeguarding concerns.
