

Sale of Alcohol at Ropley Parish Hall

Terms and Conditions for using the Hall's Alcohol Licence

If granted, the Licence is issued to the person making the booking who will be held responsible by the Committee to abide by the following:

The Licensing Act 2003 has four principal aims:

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- To ensure public safety
- The prevention of public nuisance
- The protection of children from harm

It is illegal to:

Sell or supply alcohol to anyone under 18 years of age.

Sell or supply alcohol to someone you know intends to supply that alcohol to someone under 18 years of age.

Sell or supply alcohol to anyone under the influence of alcohol.

By applying to use the Hall's licence the hirer agrees to uphold the Laws set out above.
