

SALE OF ALCOHOL AT STOCKBRIDGE TOWN HALL

The premises licence of Stockbridge Town Hall permits the sale of alcohol under the Licensing Act 2003. This notice shall be completed for each event (or series of events) at which alcohol is to be sold in the Town Hall and displayed prominently near the point of sale.

The overall responsibility for ensuring that the sale of alcohol on the Town Hall premises complies with the requirements and objectives of the 2003 Licensing Act lies with the Designated Premises Supervisor who is named in the licence as Christopher (Kim) Candler, (Personal Licence Holder Number PERS/11/1092). At this event, the overall responsibility of complying with the Act has been delegated to and accepted by;

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In particular, the above individuals have undertaken to ensure that the following conditions will be applied at this event to the best of their ability;

- Unaccompanied children (under 16) are not allowed in that part of the Town Hall premises where alcohol is being sold or consumed.
- It is illegal to sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 18. If there is doubt about the age of an individual and reasonable proof of their age is not available, then the individual will not be sold alcohol.
- It is illegal for an adult to buy alcohol for someone under the age of 18, (unless it is wine, beer or cider bought for someone over 16 to be consumed with a table meal accompanied by an adult).
- It is illegal to sell alcohol to someone who is drunk.
- Alcohol will not be sold to any person who is causing excessive noise, nuisance or disturbance.
- At no time shall unsold alcohol be left unattended. No alcohol shall be left on the premises overnight unless stored in a locked location.
- The sale of alcohol at this event is only permitted by the named individuals above. The sale of alcohol at this event is not permitted by the Designated Premises Supervisor unless this notice has been signed by all the named individuals above and is prominently displayed near the point of sale.
