Welcome to the 1st Old Town Christmas Tree Festival.



Christmas Tree Festivals have grown in popularity in recent years. They are community events that bring people and local organisations together by each decorating a Christmas tree.

This FREE event, beginning on 1st December, is a special event to mark the close of the year long celebrations of the 50th anniversary of the Old Town Partnership of Churches. It is believed this is the longest active ecumenical partnership in the UK, the key feature being that each church recognises the ministers of the other churches - in preaching, presiding at services of Holy Communion, and the joint confirmation of people into the Christian faith.

The Christmas Tree Festival will be based at our four churches: St Mary's in Commonweal Road (Anglican), Bath Road Methodist Church, Christ Church (Anglican) including the Community Centre @ Christ Church, and Immanuel United Reformed Church in Upham Road.

The idea is that each church uses its imagination to offer a different atmosphere and layout depending on building and site considerations. In this way the churches are linked through a single event.

We have nominated the Mayors Charities (CALM – Children's Cancer and Leukaemia Movement, and Swindon & North Wilts Deaf Children's Society) to be supported by the event.

Launch Event and Guided Tours



The event begins on Sunday 1st December with a guided walk (repeated on Sunday 8th December). We will be joined on 1st December by the Mayor of Swindon Kevin Parry who will officially launch the event.

The walks allow time at each church to admire the Christmas Tree displays. The timings are the same for both Sundays. There will be refreshments.

Opening – 6.30pm, Immanuel, Sunday 1st December, by our Mayor.

3.45 Meet at St Mary's Church in Commonweal Road for refreshments

4.00 The first walk on Sunday 1st December will start the Christmas Tree Festival.

4.10 Leave St Mary's

4.45 Depart from Bath Road

5.45 Depart from Christ Church

6.00 Arrive at Immanuel where our Mayor, Councillor Kevin Parry, will officially open the event.

Provision will be made for wheelchair users, please contact one of the organisers to make sure that suitable arrangements are in place.

The total distance of the walk is 1 ¼ miles, all along pavements. Most of the walk will be in darkness, but there will be street lighting. All major roads will be crossed via pedestrian controlled crossings.

In addition, the walks pass through Old Town and we will see the Old Town Christmas lights on our way



CALM – Children’s Cancer and Leukaemia Movement ~ Swindon’s Local Children’s Cancer Charity



- CALM is a registered charity, run by parents who have all experienced what it is like to have a child diagnosed with cancer
- CALM helps families that have a child receiving treatment at the Great Western Hospital in Swindon, Wiltshire
- Most of the families CALM supports are based in the Swindon and Marlborough area
- CALM is a purely voluntary charity with no paid employees
- We aim to keep all expenses as low as possible, so we can ensure money donated can help the families who need it
- CALM receives no funding from the NHS. All funds are raised by our families, with support from the local community.

Swindon and North Wiltshire Deaf Children’s Society



- This charity provides support in Swindon and North Wiltshire to families with children who are deaf or have a hearing loss
- The group was established by parents who have children with a hearing loss over 25 years ago. It is still run by volunteer parents today.
- They organise fun events, provide a great network of families and hold fund raisers. They offer information and support to children who are deaf or have a hearing loss and their families in the Swindon and North Wiltshire area through a free membership scheme
- They also work closely with audiology and other professional organisations involved in the day to day care of our children

Christ Church Programme



Christ Church, in Cricklade Street, replaced the earlier Holy Rood Church on The Lawns in 1851 as the Parish Church of Swindon. Adjoining it is the Community Centre @ Christ Church which is used for a variety of community activities such as Parent & Toddler groups, yoga, Tai Chi, dancing and private parties.

Christ Church will be lit up every day between 5-8pm from 1st – 22nd December. As well as a bright trail of light throughout the church grounds and inside the church itself there will always be crafts and refreshments available during this time as well as plenty of extra entertainment to see during the duration of the festival. Bath Road Programme



Bath Road is in the Swindon and Marlborough Methodist Circuit. Built in 1880, the church was extensively renovated in 1983. Attached to the building is Epworth Court, a sheltered Housing Scheme of Methodist Homes for the Aged.

St Mary's Programme



St Mary's on Commonweal Road was built in 1978. It is a warm and welcoming ecumenical home not just as Christ Church's 'daughter' congregation, but also the New Apostolic Church, the Church of Pentecost – Swindon PIWC and the Portuguese speaking Assembly of God. During the week, it is used by a number of community groups.

Trees outside St.Mary's will be illuminated daily between 5-8pm throughout the festival. Most of the trees will be displayed inside, and can be visited at the events below and during regular church services. Sunday Service times are: 9am St.Mary's COE; 11am New Apostolic Church; 2pm Church of Pentecost, and 6:30pm Assembly of God. There is a midweek service at 8pm on Thursdays (New Apostolic Church).

St Marys will be the starting point of the two guided walks on Sunday's 1st & 8th December from 3.45-4.10pm with refreshments available inside the church
